

## Who are we?

- 1- We are part of the International churches of Christ around the world whose members live according to the Bible's teachings. We keep up to God's Word and work hard on applying all its teachings. We expect from our members to be disciples for Christ - the Head of the Body (**Colossians 1:18**) and to build a personal conviction and a living, continuous growing relationship with God.
